

Our Mission

IRTA Mission Statement

The Illinois Retired Teachers Association is a not-for-profit organization of retired educators. The Association serves the needs and interests of its members through advocacy, education, cooperation, and socialization in a flexible organizational structure.

History

The history of the Illinois Retired Teachers Association can be traced back to 1955. At that time Dr. Ethel Percy Andrus, the founder of the National Retired Teachers Association, was working to establish organizations for each state. It was decided that Illinois should have two organizations, the RTA of Chicago and the downstate RTA. Thus, the organization of IRTA took place during the July, 1955 NRTA convention in Chicago, at which time a constitution was adopted and officers were elected. The membership of the IRTA has grown from 1,300 in 1955 to over 40,000 today.

Grassroots Advocacy

The IRTA encourages you to make your voice heard on important legislative matters. Voter Voice is IRTA's online grassroots advocacy and lobbying tool. Voter Voice makes it possible for you to directly engage with your elected officials by investing as little as 1–2 minutes of your time, from the convenience of your home. The IRTA utilizes proven internet-based technology tools from Voter Voice to launch and manage grassroots lobbying campaigns and other governmental affairs activities. This process will only take a few clicks of your mouse to complete, but it is an extremely effective method of mobilizing IRTA members across Illinois into action on legislative issues that are important to you. By working alongside our members, and speaking with one collective voice, the IRTA will continue to maintain its presence as a powerful advocate on behalf of the Illinois retired teacher community.

IRTA Foundation

In 1985, after identifying a large number of former educators who were experiencing financial difficulties because of low pensions and rising inflation, the Illinois Retired Teachers Association established the Illinois Retired Teachers Association Foundation, Inc. The initial purpose of the Foundation was to build an endowment to provide assistance to retired educators. Since that time, the Foundation has assisted retired educators with living expenses, provided scholarships to aspiring teachers, worked to protect the rights of the elderly, and provided grants to educators.



The Foundation has a statewide program that allocates approximately \$42,000 in grant money to public school educators (Pre-K through 12) for special student projects.

The IRTA Foundation also awards six \$2,000 scholarships to incoming juniors or seniors in college that are pursuing a degree in education. The winners are chosen through competition with other applicants from their own area of the state. IRTAPAC was organized to protect, preserve and improve benefits for individuals receiving a pension from the Illinois Teachers Retirement System. The Illinois Retired Teachers Association Political Action Committee funds are used to support candidates for political office. These candidates support IRTA members and the issues important to you. Contributions to the IRTAPAC will be used to enhance political awareness of IRTA members and increase their contacts with elected officials and candidates. The IRTAPAC is the political advocacy arm for you, your pension and your healthcare benefits. IRTAPAC is funded only by member's donations and no dues money is ever used to support IRTAPAC.

You can now donate directly to IRTAPAC and protect the status of retired teachers by donating just \$1.00 a month through pension deduction. The form can be found below or on the IRTA website at www.irtaonline.org.
